*Each applicant is required to demonstrate their artistic endeavors before a small committee of Lindsborg Arts Council board members. Each student should be prepared to present a 5-10 minute presentation, followed by a short interview. Students may select the best method of showcasing their artistic endeavors which may include, but are not limited to:

- -Performing a contest-level piece.
- -Presenting a portfolio.
- -Performing a theatrical selection.

Auditions/Presentations will be held on Monday afternoon (4 PM), April 8, 2024 (location to be determined)

Applicants will be notified no later than March 15th regarding their specific presentation time.

*Two \$1,500 scholarships are typically awarded. The Lindsborg Arts Council reserves the right to award scholarships at the discretion of the scholarship committee.

*Recipients are required to enroll and complete an arts-related course during their first college semester. Recipients must provide proof of enrollment from the college/university by July 31st. Once enrollment is verified, a check will be issued to the scholarship recipient's school. *Note:* It is the responsibility of the scholarship recipient to report this scholarship to their school's financial aid department.
